**Review of Systems:**

<b>Constitutional Symptoms:</b>	No recent fever, chills, or night sweats.	
<b>HEENT:</b>	Head is unremarkable for head trauma, migraine headache, or other significant problem. Ears, eyes, nose, and throat: Patient denies bleeding from nose, hearing loss, difficulty in swallowing, or thyroid disorder..	
<b>Pulmonary</b>	Patient denies coughing up blood, purulent sputum, tobacco use. Patient denies SOB, DOE, orthopnea.	
<b>GI:</b>	Denies blood in stools. Patient has regular bowel movements. Patient denies nausea, vomiting, indigestion, or abdominal pain.	
<b>GU:</b>	Patient denies dysuria, hematuria, incontinence, hesitancy, dribbling, burning with urination, history of nephrolithiasis.	
<b>Neurological:</b>	Unremarkable for numbness, fainting / passing out, disc problem, or seizure disorder	
<b>Extremities:</b>	Patient denies significant arthritis or arthralgia. Denies leg pain with ambulating. Denies pedal edema.	
<b>Lymph:</b>	No enlargement of lymph nodes.	
<b>Hematologic:</b>	No history of transfusion, easy bruising, or bleeding.	
<b>Psychiatric:</b>	Unremarkable for severe mental illness or psychotropic medication.	
<b>Skin:</b>	Patient denies skin rash or skin cancer, unexplained pruritus or jaundice.	

**Physical Examination:**

<b>General:</b>	[Appearance, development, nutrition, body habitus, deformities, attention to grooming] (i.e. XX year old well-kept and groomed, well nourished, white male, no acute distress)	
<b>Eyes:</b>	[Inspection of conjunctivae and lids, and pupil, and fundi exam] (i.e. Pupils equal and reactive to light and accommodation. Extraocular muscles intact. Sclerae nonicteric, fundi not examined)	
<b>ENT:</b>	[External inspection of ear and nose; assessment of hearing; inspection of lips, teeth, and gums; examination of oropharynx: oral mucosa, salivary glands, hard and soft palates, tongue, tonsils and posterior pharynx.] (Ears and nose appear normal. Hearing is grossly normal.. Examination of oropharynx is normal)	
<b>Neck:</b>	[Masses, overall appearances, symmetry, tracheal position, crepitus] (i.e. Neck is supple. No lymphadenopathy. Tracheal position is central. No thyromegaly.)	
<b>Chest/Thorax:</b>	[Symmetrical with equal lung expansion, breast not examined]	
<b>Resp/Lung:</b>	[Assessment of respiration, Percussion of chest, Palpation of chest, Auscultation of lungs] (i.e. Respiratory efforts are normal, no intercostal retractions, no use of accessory muscles; Percussion of chest reveals no dullness, flatness, or hyperresonance; Palpation of chest is normal; Auscultation of lungs reveals normal breath sounds, no pleural rub.)	
<b>Cardiac:</b>	[Palpitation of heart, Auscultation of heart] (The apex is in the fifth intercostal space and of normal size. There is no parasternal heave or thrill. Auscultation of heart reveals the first heart sound is normal, the second heart sound is normal split with widening of second heart sound during inspiration. There is no	

	gallop or murmur heard.)	
<b>Vascular:</b>	[Carotid arteries, Jugular Veinous Distinction, Abdominal aorta, Femoral arteries, Pedal pulses, Extremities] (Carotid artery upstroke and downstroke are normal. There are no carotid bruits. No abdominal bruits. JVD is 0 at 90 degrees. Abdominal aorta is normal in size. Femoral arteries are 2+ with no femoral bruits or pulsus alternans. Pedal pulses 2+ and symmetrical.)	
<b>GI / Abdomen:</b>	[Inspection, Palpation, and Auscultation] (Soft, nondistended, nontender. Positive bowel sounds. No hepatojugular reflux. No hepatosplenomegaly. Rectal examination not done.)	
<b>Lymph:</b>	[Examination of cervical, axillary, inguinal lymph nodes reveal no lymphadenopathy] (No lymphadenopathy)	
<b>Musculoskeletal:</b>	[Examination of gait and station; Inspection and/or palpitation of digit and nails; Muscle strength] (Gait is steady; Extremities free of clubbing, cyanosis, or petechiae; 5/5 equal muscle strength bilaterally. Extremities are free of edema or varicosities.)	
<b>Skin:</b>	[Inspection and palpation of skin] (Inspection of skin reveals no rash, ulcers, or nodules)	
<b>Neurological:</b>	[Cranial nerves; Deep tendon reflexes; Babinski; and sensation to touch, pin, and vibration] (Patient appears alert; oriented to place, person, and time; no focal deficit.)	
<b>Psychiatric:</b>	[Description of patient's judgement and insight; Orientation to time, place, and person; Recent and remote memory; Mood and affect]
